Hydrolines, Inc. was founded by John Arwood in 1986 to own and operate passenger vessels in the New York marketplace. Two high-speed passenger ferries were purpose built and placed into commuter service from New Jersey to New York City.

For his role in promoting the advancement of water transportation in the region, Mr. Arwood was presented the Robert Fulton Award for Transportation Innovation in July of 1990.

Over a period of 18 years, the company operated passenger services to Manhattan from four residential locations in New Jersey and from Brooklyn.

Hydrolines assumed a pivotal role in maritime services including close affiliation with the United States Coast Guard. This led to the creation of a Natural Working Group, which helped set operating rules for high-speed commercial crafts. The company remains a member of the Passenger Vessel Association..
